



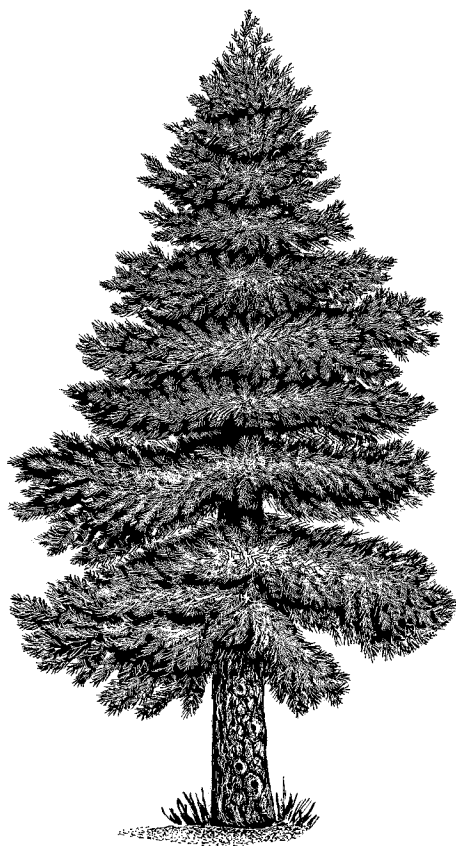

It can often be hard to find plants that will survive in dry and shady conditions. It often occurs under evergreen trees in combination with sandy soils. Luckily, we do have some native plants that are adapted for such conditions!
