



Native Plants for Hummingbirds

Hummingbirds are very attracted to long tubular red and orange flowers. However, they will also sip nectar from a variety of other flowers as well. They need nectar all season long, so it is important to plant flowers with a variety of bloom times in your hummingbird garden. Wild Columbine is a great early season flower, Cardinal Flower and Beebalm are mid-season, and Cutleaf Coneflower is a good late season bloom.
