# New York Natives for Dry, Sunny Sites

Tired of struggling to amend your sandy soil so that something will grow? Stop fighting a losing battle - and instead plant native plants that are adapted to dry, sunny sites with sandy/gravelly infertile soils. These plants don't want rich soil - so you actually don't want to have good soil - or use amendments like compost. They thrive in tough, gravelly soils that are well drained and low in nutrients.
