

Bluets

Houstonia caerulea



zones: 3-9

native: NY and ADKs

light: sun to part sun

soil: wet to dry

flower color: light blue with yellow center

height: 3-6"

spacing: 6"

bloom: May-June

Notes: Also called Quaker Ladies, these little blooms make a great groundcover in the garden - and can even withstand light foot traffic - so you can plant them along a patio or stone walkway.
